

# Care instructions for equestrian arenas with stresan<sup>®</sup>



## Cleaning

To increase the lifetime of the riding ground, we recommend to regularly remove the horse droppings as well as other pollutions of the trad layer (e. g. foliage).



## Smooth the track

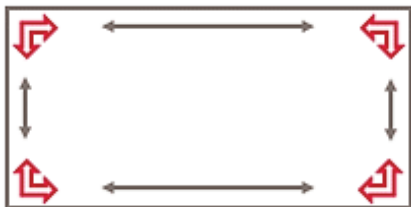
To keep the riding ground smooth, we recommend to pull or to rake the accumulated sand of the track in the arena 1x daily.



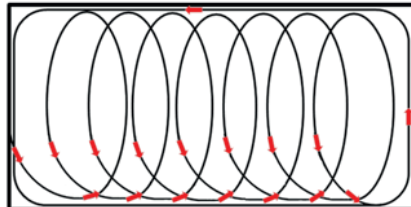
## Drag with equestrian arena leveller

Depending on intensity of use we recommend to regularly drag the riding ground with a suitable equestrian arena leveller.

**1.** Go around outside of the track, go backwards in every corner to drag the accumulated sand from the corner.



**2.** Drive trace moved in circles, until the other end of the riding surface is reached.



**3.** Drive just about the centre line and then drive trace moved in the rectangle on the whole riding arena.



## Irrigation

Depending on intensity of use and weather conditions, we recommend to water the riding ground regularly and evenly, but be careful not to over water. Before the irrigation the ground should be dragged.

**Tip:** To determine the optimum moist degree, you can form from the sand a ball, this may not crumble (too drily) or dissolve (too wet).



## Maintenance

We recommend to get your riding surface aligned with a laser grader once per year, so that the riding ground has the same trad everywhere. Also, fill in sand if required.

**Tip:** To make the trad layer suited for winter, magnesium chloride can be added.
